For vscode one can see that the Shift-Alt-A keys (for block comment) are somewhat easier to press than typical three key combos but it's so non-intuitive as a keyboard shortcut.

ReSharper uses Ctrl+Alt+/ and Ctrl+Shift+/ for line and block comment respectively.
